Advanced anatomical orientation of the pterygoid region and zygoma is essential for successful placement of pterygoid and zygomatic implants, especially in severely atrophic maxillae. A thorough understanding of the maxillary tuberosity, pterygoid plates, zygomatic body, and surrounding vital structures. Surgical Protocol involves detailed radiographic planning using CBCT, precise angulation of the osteotomy, controlled drilling to engage dense cortical bone and implant insertion.
